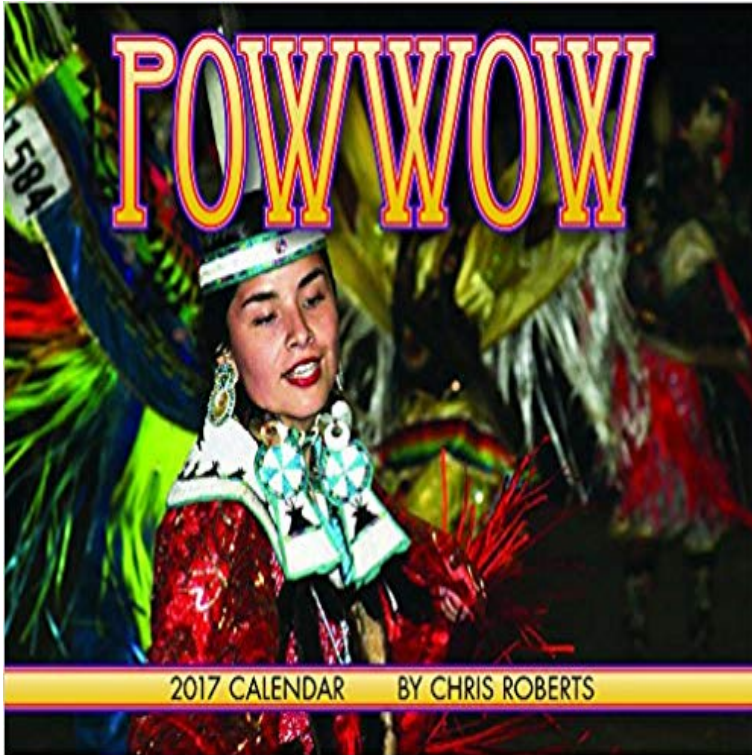


Powwow 2017 Calendar
