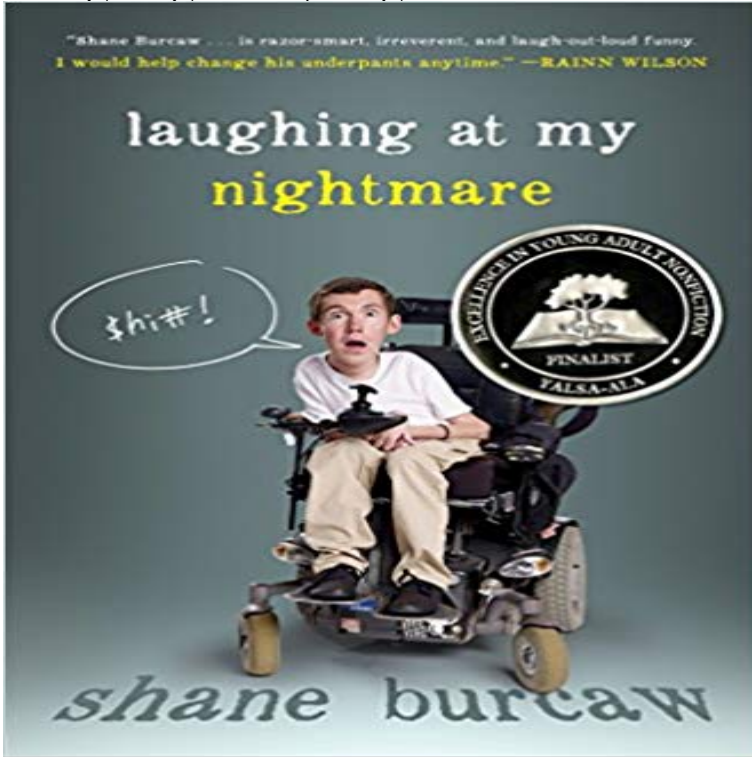


Laughing at My Nightmare
