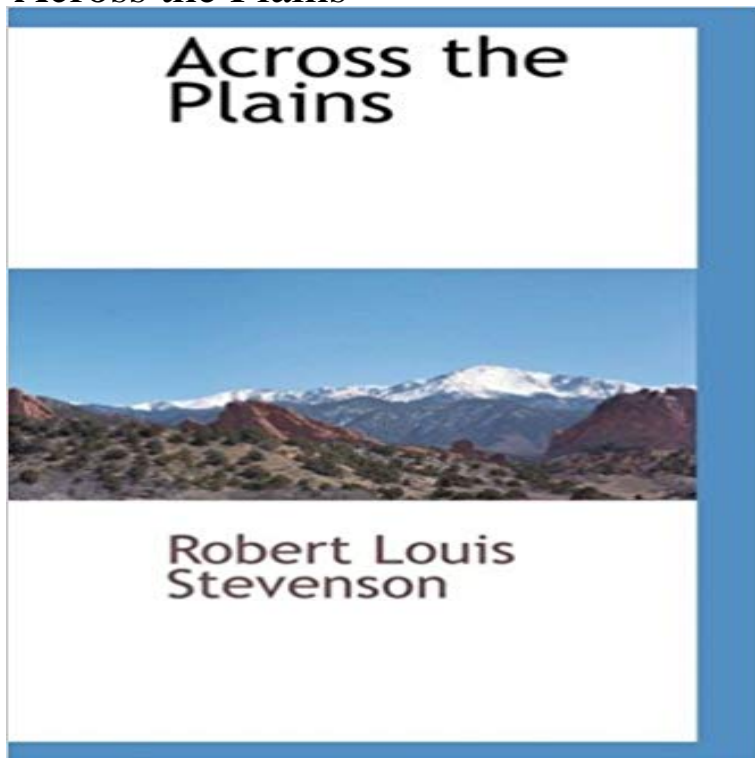


## Across the Plains
