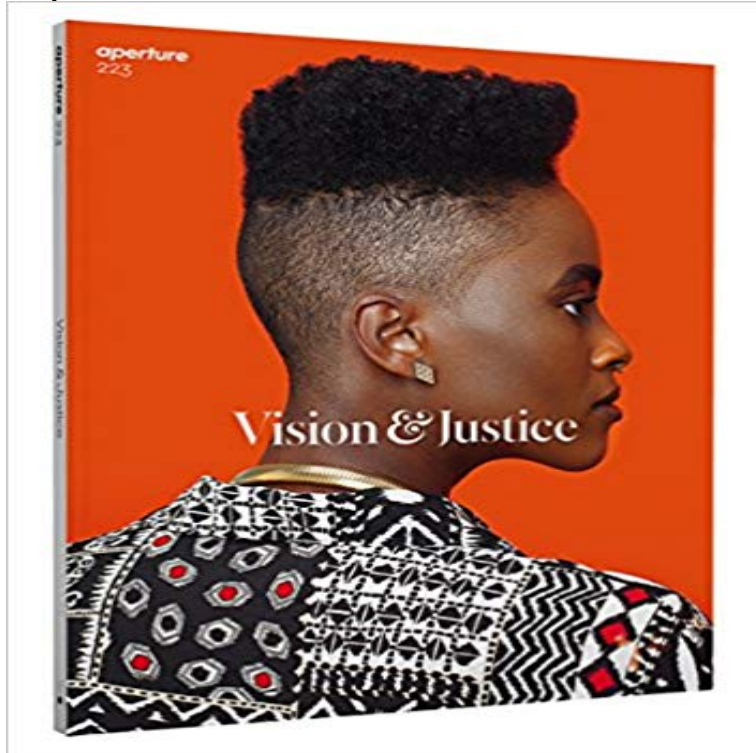


## Aperture 223: Summer 2016: Vision & Justice
