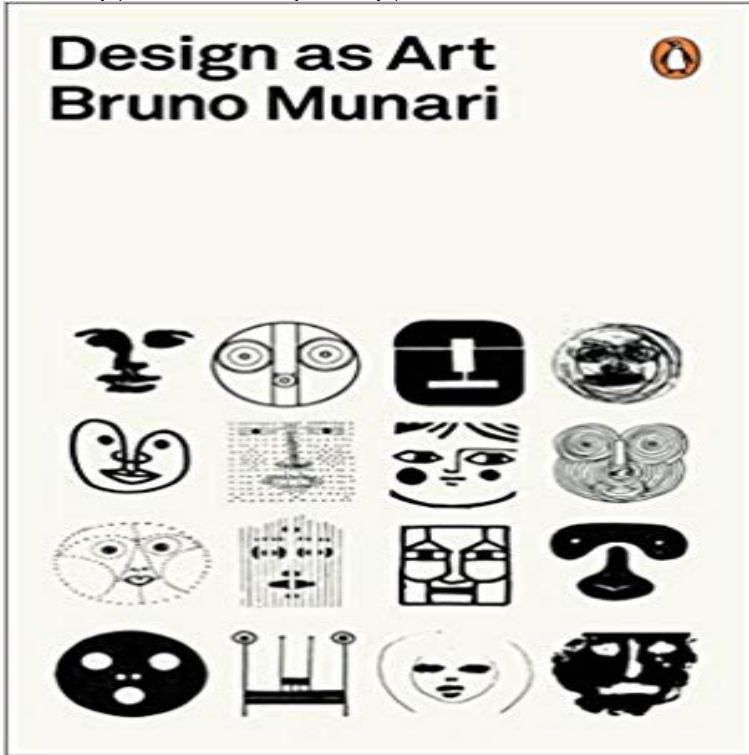


Design as Art (Penguin Modern Classics)
