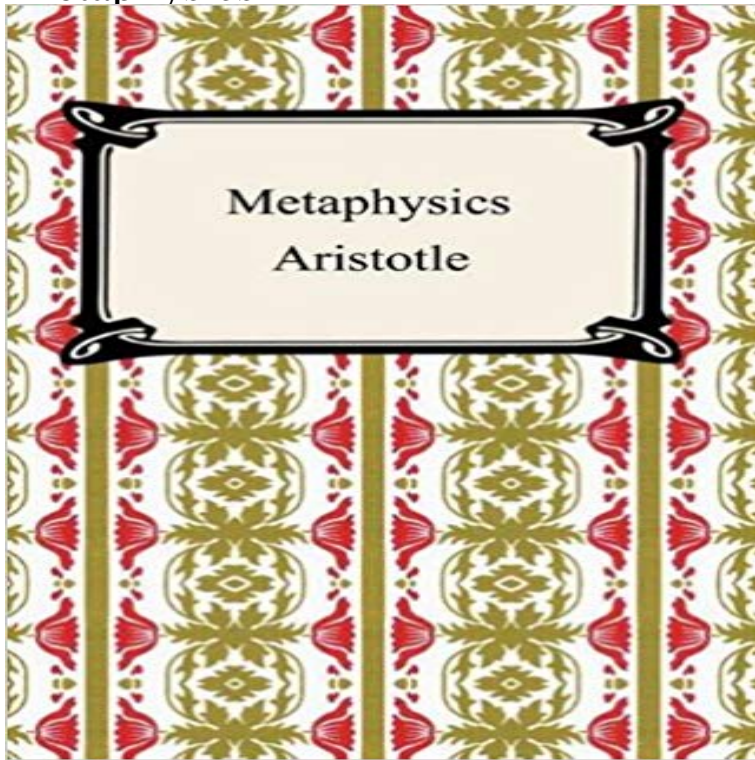


Metaphysics
