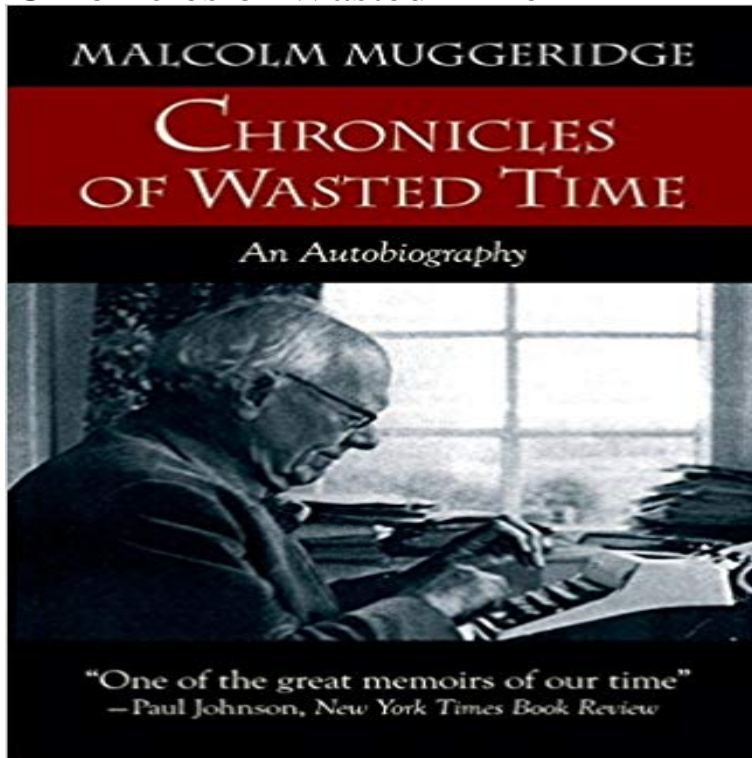


Chronicles of Wasted Time

As a journalist he worked around the world on the *Guardian*, *Calcutta Statesman*, the *Evening Standard* and the *Daily Telegraph*. In 1953 became editor of *Punch*, where he remained for four years. In later years he became best known as a broadcaster both on television and radio for the BBC. His other books include *Jesus Rediscovered*, *Christ and the Media*, and *A Third Testament*.
