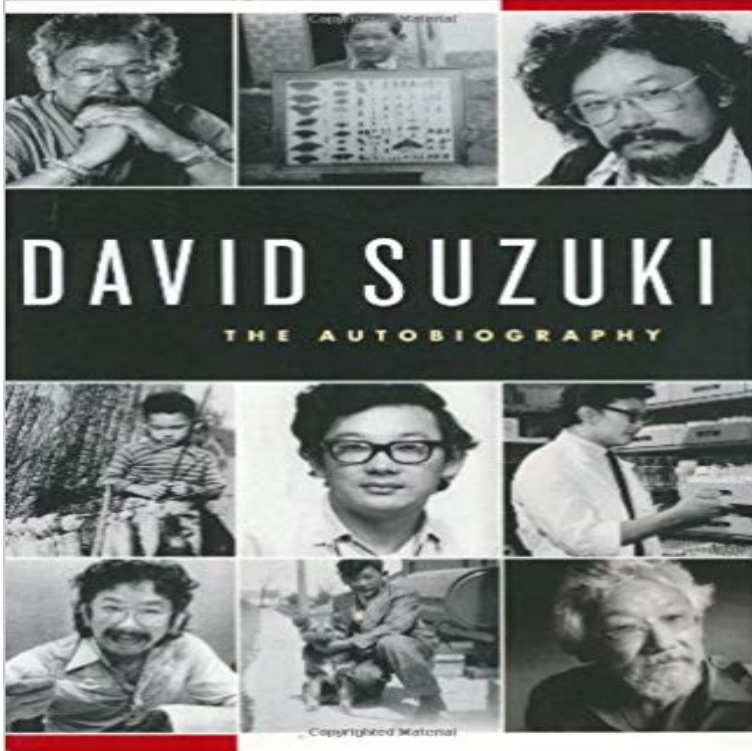


David Suzuki: The Autobiography
