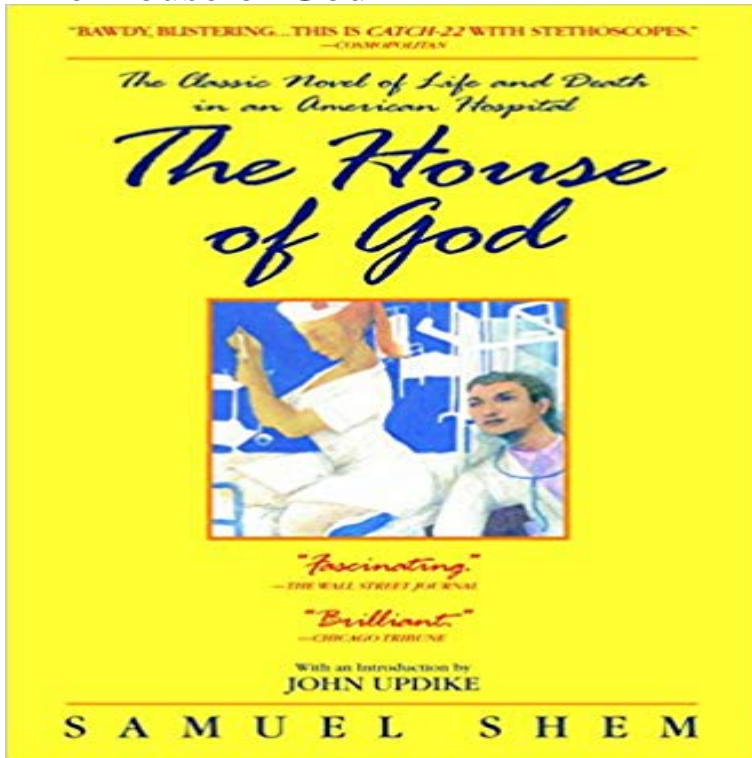


# The House of God
