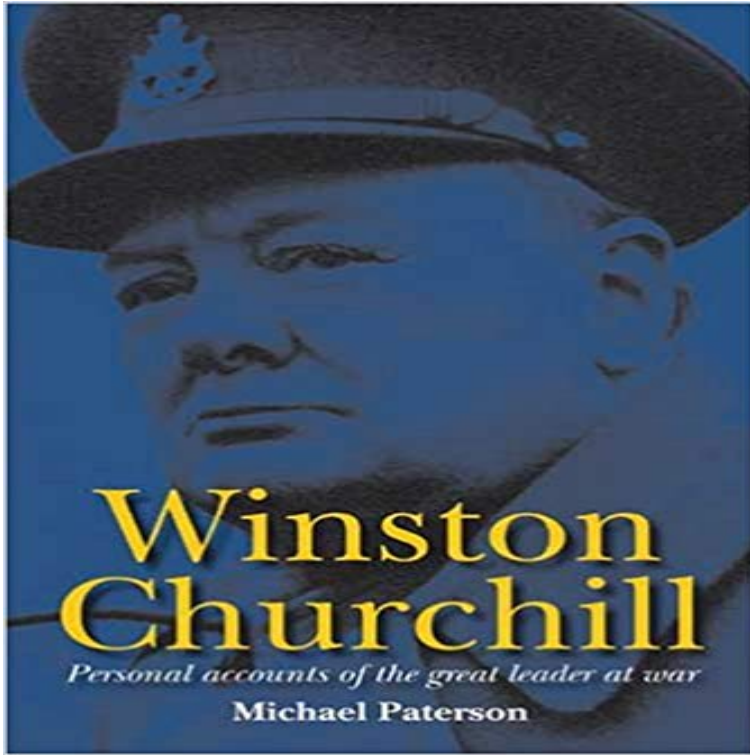


Winston Churchill: Personal Accounts of the Great Leader at War
