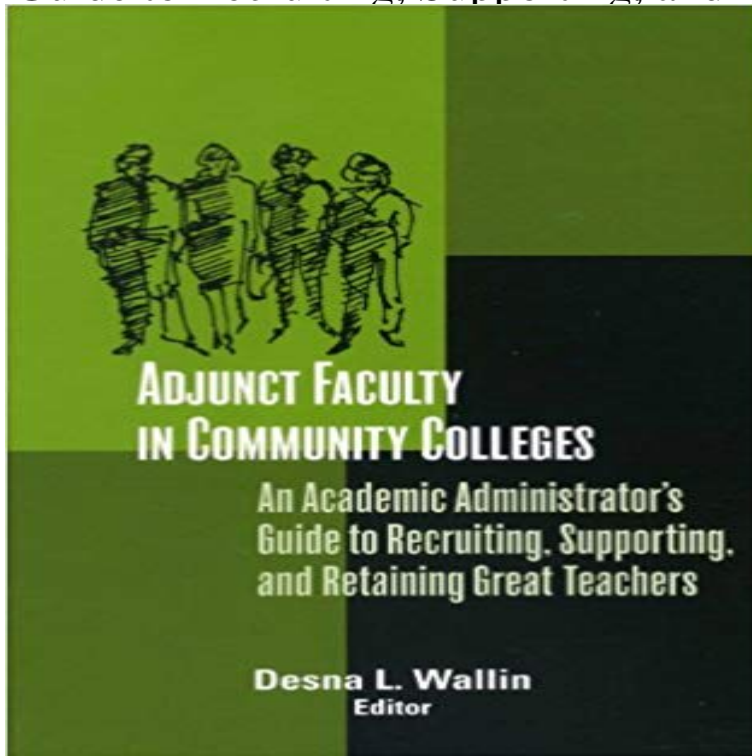


# Adjunct Faculty in Community Colleges: An Academic Administrators Guide to Recruiting, Supporting, and Retaining Great Teachers
