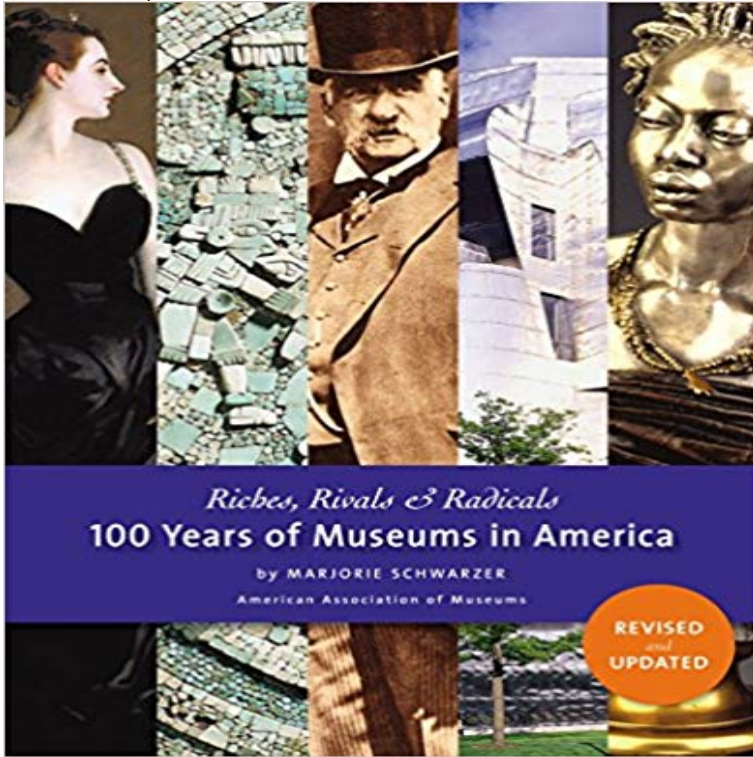


Riches, Rivals and Radicals: 100 Years of Museums in America
