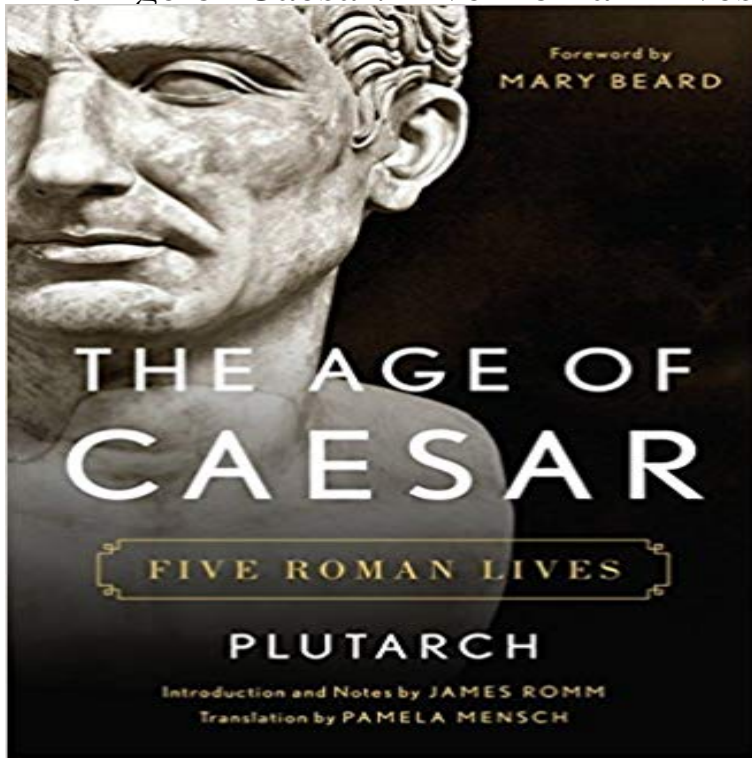


The Age of Caesar: Five Roman Lives
