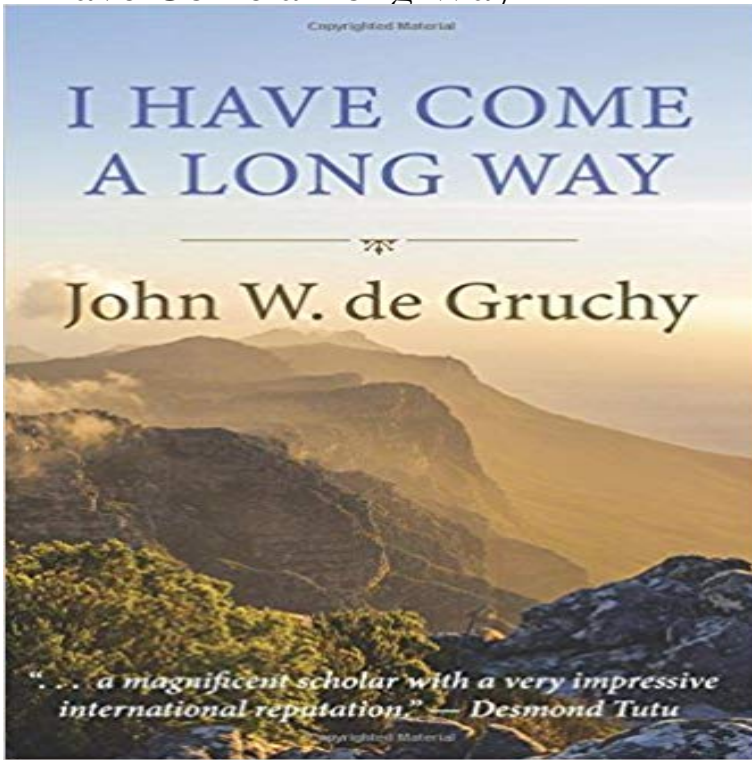


I Have Come a Long Way
