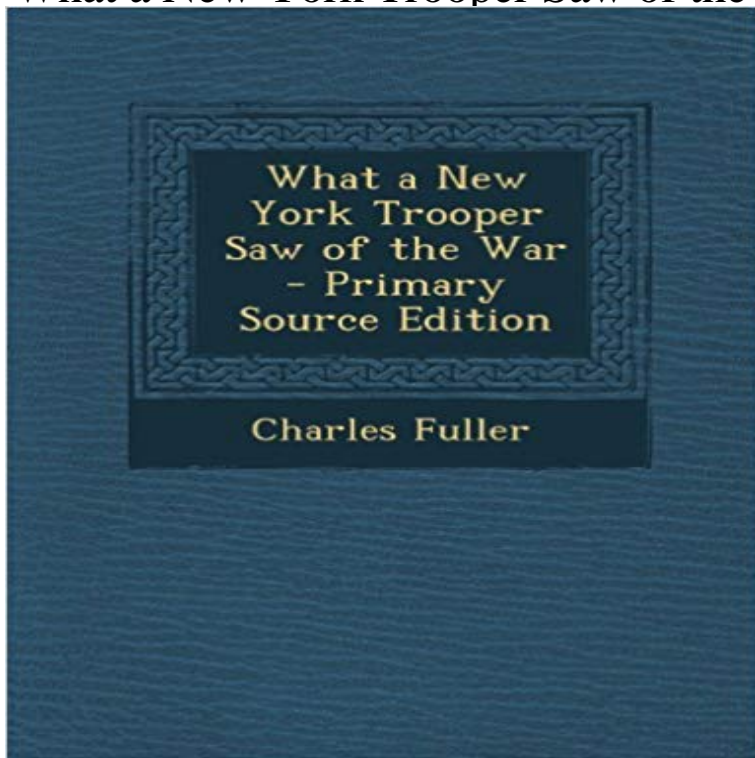


# What a New York Trooper Saw of the War
